### Summary:

On Thursday, April 14, 2016 the Senate Appropriations Committee passed its version of the FY17 Military Construction and Veterans Affairs Appropriations Bill. In total, the legislation provides \$83 billion in discretionary funding – \$3.1 billion above the fiscal year 2016 level.

The bill includes \$673 million for construction or alteration of Guard and Reserve facilities in 21 states, an increase of \$122 million above the fiscal year 2016 enacted level. Of this, \$232.9 million is provided for Army National Guard military construction and \$143.9 million for Air National Guard military construction – both at requested levels.

## Senate Provisions of Interest

### ***Military Construction, Army National Guard***

For construction, acquisition, expansion, rehabilitation, and conversion of facilities for the training and administration of the Army National Guard, and contributions therefor, as authorized by chapter 1803 of title 10, United States Code, and Military Construction Authorization Acts, \$232,930,000, to remain available until September 30, 2021.

### ***Military Construction, Air National Guard***

For construction, acquisition, expansion, rehabilitation, and conversion of facilities for the training and administration of the Air National Guard, and contributions therefor, as authorized by chapter 1803 of title 10, United States Code, and Military Construction Authorization Acts, \$143,957,000, to remain available until September 30, 2021.

**SEC. 125.** For an additional amount for the accounts and in the amounts specified, to remain available until September 30, 2021: “Military Construction, Army National Guard”, \$16,500,000; “Military Construction, Air National Guard”, \$11,000,000. *Provided*, That such funds may only be obligated to carry out construction projects identified in the respective military department’s unfunded priority list for fiscal year 2017 submitted to Congress: *Provided further*, That such funds are subject to authorization prior to obligation and expenditure of funds to carry out construction: *Provided further*, That not later than 30 days after enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the military department concerned, or their designee, shall submit to the Committees on Appropriations of both Houses of Congress an expenditure plan for funds provided under this section.

## Senate Report Language of Interest

### ***Army National Guard Readiness Center Transformation Plan:***

The Committee is concerned by the current state of the portfolio, and supports increased investments in National Guard Readiness Centers in accordance with the Readiness Center Transformation Master Plan so that they can better meet the needs of the Army Guard. Therefore, the Committee encourages the Department to prioritize investment in Readiness Center facilities with low readiness ratings, and to examine where efficiencies and cost-sharing can be achieved by co-locating Readiness Centers with other public facilities. The Committee further directs the Army to provide a report no later than 120 days after enactment of this Act on a plan to implement, as a first step, the National Guard’s “Affordable Readiness” Transformation Plan, including an annual investment estimate based on the proposed 15-year implementation timeline.
