SPECIAL OPERATIONS VECTOR 3 HALO, HAHO (SOV-3HH) MILITARY PARACHUTE, MILITARY TANDEM TETHER BUNDLE PARACHUTE

1. Background. Pararescue (PJ) and Special Tactics (ST) forces require the SOV-3HH military solo system parachute as recent operations have demonstrated that currently fielded parachutes do not function well at high altitudes. Today's PJ/ST forces carry more equipment to accomplish the combat search and rescue mission and special operations mission. Consequently, PJ/ST require a parachute that can support the additional weight as well as function safely at high altitudes. The SOV-3HH parachute will allow PJ/ST to accomplish all missions, including High Altitude Low Opening /High Altitude High Opening, static line and free fall missions. PJ/ST forces also require the capability to deliver non-parachute qualified individuals to austere locations via the military "tandem" parachute where specialized care and treatment is required.

2. Requirement. Combat Search and Rescue Mission Area Plan. Lessons learned Operation ENDURING FREEDOM.

3. Impact If Not Funded. PJ/ST forces will be limited in the environments in which they are deployed. Safety risks become plausible during high altitude missions like those performed during Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. Without a military "tandem" parachute, PJ/ST forces will lack the capability to deliver non- parachute qualified critical care personnel to casualty locations.
