Executive Summary

On 16 December, the President signed H.R. 3288, the vehicle making appropriations for six appropriations bills including Military Construction and Veterans Affairs. The Senate adopted the report on 13 December, which was previously adopted by the House on 10 December. The report includes large increases in Army and Air National Guard military construction funding.

While all Reserve Components received significant increases in funding above requested levels for military construction, the Army and Air National Guard received larger increases than any other Army or Air Force active or reserve component -- receiving a total of nearly \$400 million in additional military construction funding above the budget request.

The report includes \$582,056,000 for the Army National Guard, which includes \$514,580,000 in projects; \$30,000,000 from the Guard and Reserve Initiative; and \$47,429,000 in Study, Planning and Design. The \$582,056,000 in the appropriations bill matches the amount authorized by the National Defense Authorization Act for fiscal year 2010.

The report also includes \$371,226,000 for the Air National Guard, which includes \$311,000,000 in projects; \$30,000,000 from the Guard and Reserve Initiative; and \$20,021,000 in Study, Planning, and Design. The \$371,226,000 in the appropriations bill is \$7,000,000 above the amount authorized by the National Defense Authorization Act for fiscal year 2010.

The funds in the report include \$30,000,000 for each the Army and Air National Guard from a total of \$200,000,000 in the Guard and Reserve Initiative account.

The report funds 62 Army National Guard and 41 Air National Guard projects including all projects which had previously been listed in the House and Senate bills and reports.

House Committee Report Language

Future Year Defense Plans and Quadrennial Defense Review The Committee is concerned by the Department of Defense's decision not to release a Future Years Defense Plan (FYDP) for military construction and family housing programs, despite the clear requirement to submit one annually under 10 U.S.C. 221. The FYDP provides Congress with a clear statement of the Department's present and anticipated requirements and priorities across all services, components, and Defense agencies. The difficulty created for the Committee by this decision is compounded by the unanswered questions surrounding major initiatives with significant impacts on military construction, some of which have been incorporated in the Quadrennial Defense Review (QDR) process. These unresolved questions include the stationing of Army units following the Secretary of Defense's decision to reduce the number of planned brigade combat teams; the force posture of US forces, particularly the Army, in the European Command area of responsibility; the Navy's intention to establish a second east coast nuclear carrier homeport; the strategy and timetable for the realignment of 8,000 marines and their families from Okinawa to Guam; the training requirements for Marine Corps forces in the Pacific; and the ultimate disposition of the proposed ballistic missile defense system in Europe. The Committee expects the Department to promptly inform the Committee when decisions on future plans are finalized.

<u>Guard and Reserve Initiative</u> The Committee recommends \$200,000,000 for a Guard and Reserve initiative to address urgent unfunded requirements for the Army National Guard, Air National Guard, Army Reserve, Navy, and Marine Corps Reserve, and Air Force Reserve. The Committee recognizes the critical contribution made by reserve component personnel to disaster assistance, homeland security, and national defense, including the burdens borne by the Guard and Reserve to support overseas contingency operations. The Committee has included language directing that spending plans be submitted for the funds provided no later than 30 days after the enactment of this Act.
