Subject: Joint Coalition and Warfighting (JCW) Joint Qualification Report for FY12 3rd Quarter

The Department of Defense Joint Officer Management Joint Qualification System Implementation Plan, 30 March 2007, outlines the multi-level joint qualification concept and identifies lead and supporting organizations responsible for its operations effective 1 October 2007.

The Goldwater-Nichols Department of Defense Reorganization Act of 1986 set the criteria for joint positions that the Defense Department has used ever since. The new Joint Qualification System, announced on 30 July 2007, keeps in place the tenets of the act, but allows for the post-9/11 operating environment. The new system, which took effect 1 October 2007, offers an additional "experience-based" track with a point system for recognizing joint service. The original track remains in place, but the second track allows for awarding partial credit or for awarding credit for an expanded list of joint positions. All original educational requirements remain in place, but some credit can be given for additional education, training, and exercises.

The new system recognizes the skills that aid U.S. military efforts to respond to national security threats, as well as interagency, combat operations, and humanitarian crises. It also accounts for the intensity, environment, and duration or frequency of a joint activity. A key change is the ability to award credit to reserve component officers, previously not allowed.

Active-duty officers will be able to recover credit for positions served since 11 September 2001. Reserve component officers who served in qualifying joint assignments from 1 October 1986, until 30 September 2007, may be awarded joint duty credit. As of 1 October 2008, active component officers are required to complete a full joint duty assignment and be designated a joint qualified officer for appointment to the rank of general or flag officer.





1. <u>Joint Qualification System</u>: The Joint Qualification System (JQS) authorized in NDAA 2007 (Public law 109-364) provides a dual track opportunity to earn joint qualifications. Refer to references (a) and (b) for additional information.

2. <u>Joint Qualification System Primer</u>: The JQS provides Active and Reserve component officers an opportunity to earn joint qualifications upon completion of the requisite joint professional military education <u>and</u> completion of a full tour of duty in a joint assignment (via either the *standard path* or the *experience path*). [NOTE: "Standard path" equates to serving in a Joint Duty Assignment List (JDAL) position. "Experience path" means services in a non-JDAL position for which an officer may request the experience be considered for award of joint experience points.]

a. Joint Qualification - Standard Path

- (1) Assignment to a position listed on the JDAL is considered to be the "standard path" to earning joint qualifications. JDAL positions are selectively filled based on screening by the Services and the joint organizations. Generally, officers serving in a JDAL position are O-4 and above.
- (2) Except for assignments terminated by joint duty tour length waivers or for one of the reasons listed in enclosure 7 of reference (a), Active Component (AC) and full-time Reserve Component (RC) officers in grades O-6 and below must complete at least three years and G/FOs must complete at least two years in order to earn "full" joint duty credit.
- (3) The tour length for RC officers who perform duty periodically in a JDAL position is set at six accumulative years for O-6s and below (initial assignment not less than three years) and four cumulative years for G/FOs (initial assignment not less than two years).
- (4) A tour of duty in which an officer serves in more than one joint duty assignment without a break between such assignments shall be considered to be a single tour of duty in a joint duty assignment.

b. Joint Qualification - Experience Path

(1) Officer in the grades of O-1 through O-6 may self-nominate their experiences and request award of "joint experience points" by going to: https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/appj/jmis/JQSindex.jsp. Refer to reference (b) for additional information.



- (2) Submissions are first screened and vetted by the Service Joint Officer Management and Personnel/Human Resource staffs before being forwarded to the Joint Staff for evaluation by a Joint Experience Review Panel.
- (3) The Joint Experience Review Panel is chaired by DJ-1 and composed of senior officers representing the Services.
- (a) The Panel may: (1) recommend disapproval of the experience as clearly not having met the standard; (2) validate the experience as meeting the standard and determine the intensity factor to be applied; or (3) take no action.
- (b) The Panel forwards a <u>recommendation</u> that officers with validated joint experiences be awarded joint experience points by the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff; recommendations for disapproval are also forwarded. The Vice Director, Joint Staff, has been delegated approval authority on behalf of the Chairman.
- (4) Officers in the grade of O-7 (or O-7 select) should contact their Service General or Flag Officer Matters office for details on how to self-nominate experiences.
- c. <u>Levels of Joint Qualification</u>: The JQS offers four levels of joint qualification [Level I, Level II, Level III (also known as "JQO," and Level IV] to recognize the career-long accumulation of joint knowledge, skills, and abilities.

LEVEL	CRITERIA
J	 a. Awarded upon joint certification of pre-commissioning and basic officer course completion. These courses provide learning objectives dealing with "Joint Introduction and Awareness." b. Junior Officers are focused on Service competencies. c. Qualification points begin to accrue following commissioning via opportune joint experiences, joint training, joint exercises, and other education.
II	 a. Awarded upon completion of JPME Phase I and accrual of 18 points and certification by the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. b. A minimum of 12 points must come from "Joint Experience." c. Discretionary points may be derived from joint experience, joint training, joint exercises, and other education. NOTE: Officers who have Full Joint Tour Credit and have completed JPME Phase I may be nominated by their Service, in accordance with procedures established by the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, to be designated as Level II

Officers must be a G/FO (for pay purposes) for at least one day while filling the G/FO S-JDA or during the period for which joint experience points are earned

- 3. <u>Joint Matters Statutory Definition</u>. Whether validating a position for placement on the JDAL or validating individual experiences, the criteria that must be met in the statutory definition of "joint matters" both "what you do" and "who you do it with" aspects:
- a. WHAT: <u>Matters related to the achievement of unified action</u> by integrated military forces in operations conducted across domains such as land, sea or air, in space, or in the information environment, including matters relating to:
 - (1) National military strategy;
 - (2) Strategic planning and contingency planning;
 - (3) Command and control of operations under unified command;
 - (4) National security planning with other departments and agencies of the United States; or
 - (5) Combined operations with military forces of allied nations.
- b. WHO: In the context of joint matters, the term "integrated military forces" refers to military forces that are involved in the planning or execution (or both) of operations involving participants from
 - (1) more than one military department; or
 - (2) military department and one or more of the following:
 - (a) Other departments and agencies of the United States;
 - (b) The military forces or agencies of other countries; or
 - (c) Non-governmental persons or entities.

4. Joint Certification Process.

- a. Reference (b) states the Director for Joint Force Development (J-7) will identify, maintain, and publish a list of joint exercises that have direct relevance to the definition of joint matters on at least an annual basis.
- b. Reference (c) states the requirements for a course to be certified as joint. Any entity may identify joint content and provide data to support the eight criteria. These criteria are examined, and if found to meet the requirements, a certification package is prepared that outlines the details. The certification package is staffed at JSJ7/JCW. Once signed, content is deemed to be Joint certified. The joint course certification criteria are cited below:



- (1) Content must meet a joint training requirement that supports a joint operational need as identified in a Combatant Commander's joint training plan, or any other authoritative joint document.
 - (2) Content must be in accordance current joint doctrine.
 - (3) Learning objectives must link to current Universal Joint Tasks.
- (4) Course must have an assessment that tests and documents a learner's achievement of the training objectives. The course must have an evaluation standard, such as pass/fail or minimum score.
- (5) Course must have a lifecycle maintenance plan. Courses that have been certified as joint must be reviewed, updated, and recertified regularly to reflect revisions in joint doctrine, time-sensitive information, and/or content modifications to ensure content currency and accuracy.
- (6) Course should support the interest of two or more Military Departments and be accessible to all Service personnel who meet course requirements. Ideally, the intent is for all Services to be able to accept the program of instruction as meeting appropriate course content.
- (7) Joint course instructors must possess relevant experience and knowledge of joint operations and/or activities related to the course.
 - (8) Course should not duplicate existing material.
- c. Course certification will expire three years from the date certified. Extensions will be granted on a case by case basis. The Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) can pull certification at any time.
- d. Joint certified courses can be found in Appendix A, and joint certified exercises can be found in Appendix C. JQO points may be accrued by completing joint certified individual training courses.
- 5. <u>Discretionary Points</u>: Joint Staff, J7 serves as the action office for certification and scoring of individual Joint training in support of the Office of the Secretary of Defense chaired Joint Officer Management board. It provides course certification outreach, identifies new individual Joint training sources from the combatant commands, Services, and Combat Support Agencies and monitors exercises for joint credit. The following matrixes describe points awarded based on cumulative credit hours and exercise participation:

<16 hours	0 points
16 - 39 hours	0.5 point
40 - 59 hours	1 point
60 - 99 hours	1.5 points
≥ 100 hours	2 points

COURSE INFORMATION

- 1. <u>Course Method</u>: Courses are identified as Distributed Learning (DL), Institutional Learning (IL), or Blended Learning (BL).
- 2. <u>Course Number.</u> Courses identified as IL and BL are assigned independently by the school (or OPR); DL course numbers are assigned by DDJ7 JCW/JKO.
- 3. <u>Course Taxonomy</u>. The DL course number taxonomy is defined as: Joint Functional Area, Levels of War, Origin of Course, and Course numbering-course module. For example: J3OP-US124.
