



2020: The Year of the Guard

Response Peak Numbers

- **120,091:** Guard members engaged worldwide (June 6).
- **86,400:** Domestic Operations support (June 8).
- **47,100:** COVID-19 support in 50 states, 3 territories and DC (May 10).
- **43,351:** Civil disturbance support in 34 states and DC (June 7).
- **10.9 million:** Days supporting our communities (DOMOPs) in FY20.

2020 truly demonstrated the National Guard's ability to perform simultaneous combat and homeland response missions

The year 2020 required unprecedented and historic National Guard homeland response efforts, while operating in the most complex and dangerous global security environment since the end of the Cold War.

National Guard members supported every global Combatant Commander requirement – more than 1 million overseas deployments since 9/11 -- and met every Governor request at home.

The manning, training, equipment National Guard service members receive to support combat missions overseas significantly contributes to our homeland response success.

Warfight training and resourcing has enabled rapid and unified responses to the COVID, Operation Warp Speed, civil disturbance, severe weather, wildfire, election support, and counter-drug missions.

The investment America has made to ensure the NG is ready for our combat mission is paying dividends in our communities -- saving lives, protecting property, and expediting recovery efforts.
