- Cross-organization coordination.

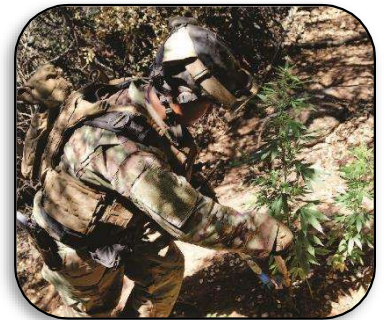
