

National Guard Bureau Joint Liaison Team (JLT)

Highlights

JLT Capabilities:

- Enhances existing information exchange between the States Inter-agency partners, and NGB
- Assists with the collection, reporting and sharing of information to the NGB-JOC
- Assists in the coordination of requests for information (RFIs and requests for assistance (RFAs) between JFHQs-State and NGB

JLT Tailored Response:

- State requests a NGB JLT to assist with small or large events, requiring a wide range of ARNG and ANG expertise
- JLT composition of personnel and equipment can be tailored to the State's request

JLT Equipment:

- Laptops with wireless internet
- Satellite Communications
- IRIDUM Phones

JLT does not:

- Provide augmentation or sustainment support for JFHQs-State, Joint Task Force, or staffing due to readiness shortfalls
- Provide evaluation of Defense Sup port to Civil Authority (DSCA) functions (i.e. Joint Reception, Stag ing, Onward Movement, and Inte gration (JRSOI))
- Supplement State JOC White Cells





Providing requested support to states during crisis

Mission:

Under the direction of the CNGB, the JLT provides shared situational awareness (SSA) and liaison support between the NGB and supported National Guard (NG) Joint Force Headquarters-State (JFHQs-State) and inter-organizational partners during domestic operations (DOMOPS) including homeland defense (HD), defense support of civil authorities (DSCA), National Special Security Events (NSSEs), and national exercises.

As a crisis or training event develops, NGB and State leaders coordinate response actions and determine if JLT support is required. The JLTs will initiate movement within 24 hours of decision and deploy with mission critical communications equipment. The JLT and communications suite will not impose a burden on the State's Joint Operations Center (JOC).

NGB staffs ten, four-person, JLTs capable of sustaining 24hr operations. Composition of JLTs can be tailored to include elements for Personnel (J1), Intelligence (J2), Operations (J3), Logistics (J4), Communications (J6), Public Affairs, ANG and ARNG.
