This letter is to acknowledge receipt and receive clarification and a fee agreement for your Freedom of Information Act request dated April 8, 2010 for records on all current "technology" contractors and subcontractors doing business with the National Guard Bureau. Your request was received on April 8, 2010 and assigned case #J-10-0022.

In order to begin processing your request, we are asking for clarification on what specific Directorate and what Branch (Office) within the National Guard Bureau Joint Staff you are requesting a search for records to be conducted. A listing of the Directorates and Offices under the National Guard Bureau can be found at <http://www.ng.mil/jointstaff/default.aspx>. As a preliminary estimate only, I would estimate that it would be a 1 hour search time within each office to conduct a search and consolidate a listing to respond to your request and the review time would vary depending on the volume of records produced in response to the search outcome.

In addition, our office needs a fee agreement in order to begin conducting a search for responsive records. As a requestor in the "commercial" fee category, you will be responsible for all search time to locate and determine which records would be responsive to your request, as well as review time to determine which portions of the records may be released or require removal of information exempt under the Freedom of Information Act. You will also be responsible for all reprographics costs for records released to you.

The fees assessed for processing of a request can be found on the Department of Defense Form 2086, which can be found at: <http://www.dtic.mil/whs/directives/infomgt/forms/eforms/dd2086.pdf>. Generally speaking, most of the search and review time is done by individuals falling within the "Professional" category which has a \$44.00 per hour charge.

Your request has been placed on hold pending your clarification on which of the estimated 30 offices you are asking for a search to be conducted and your expression of your willingness to pay fees for processing. If we do not receive clarification and/or the fee agreement by April 28, 2010 we will presume you are no longer interested and will administratively close your request; however, this does not preclude you from making a request in the future.

Your request is currently at position #54 in our queue for processing and we would estimate, as a preliminary estimate only, completion of this request by September 30, 2010.

In your request, you did not indicate your willingness to pay fees for processing. As a requestor in the commercial fee category, you will be responsible for all search and review time, as well as reprographics. The National Guard Bureau Principal Assistant for Contracting has indicated it will take approximately 90 minutes to create each report in their database.
