





I enlisted in the KYARNG on 29JAN2009 as an 88M which was considered a Critical Skill MOS. I found out later through other soldiers that a new engineering unit was starting up in Chippewa Falls WI and I put in for a transfer. I reclassified into the 21T MOS in September of 2010 by attending a one month training course in Camp Grafton ND. I chose Wisconsin because I do have family and friends in this area. After transferring I was assured my paperwork had gone through and I asked specifically about my bonus and was told it was still intact. Now I am being told that I only received the bonus due to my joining in a critical skill MOS and since my transferring to a non-critical skill MOS I am no longer deserving of it. I was never told that my bonus would be revoked due to my MOS transfer, had I been informed I would not have changed my MOS and would have found a unit as an 88M.
